We are so pleased that Eldon of Acorn Catering is willing to continue working with us. We expect to keep the price of our membership meeting at \$30 for at least the rest of this year.

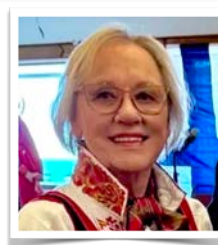

Square Payment Now Accepted at Norway Park!

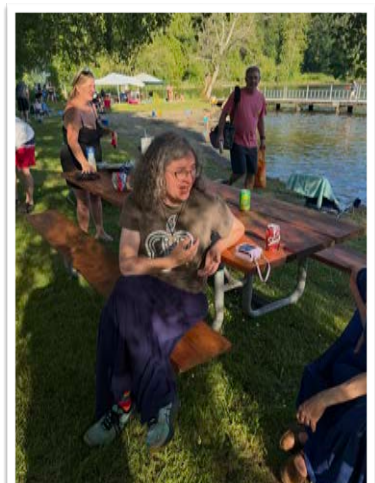


Until recently, cash was King at the lower park for day use or camping; the LERA Board approved the Square Payment System as an option and has been in use this past month.

The books listed below have been most recently translated from Norsk to English. All books are available on Amazon, including the audio version.



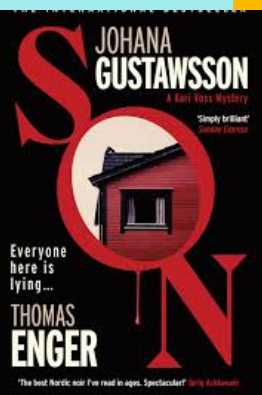
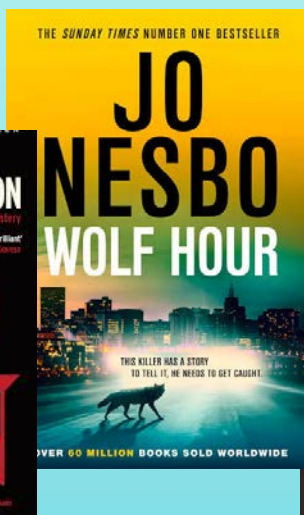
"Son" by Thomas Enger & Johana

Gustawsson (Translated in June 2026): This immediate psychological hit introduces Kari Voss, a behavioral and body-language expert who must navigate a dark double-homicide that ties directly to her own missing son's past.

"Into the Dark" by Ørjan Karlsson (Translated by Ian Giles, May 2026): The second standalone entry in The Arctic Mysteries series published by Orenda Books, delivering a chilly, atmospheric political conspiracy set in Norway's far north.

Ballard's (og Verden's) mest berømte Vaskebjørn JIMOTHY!



Den 26. juli 2026 ble det arrangert en offentlig markering i parken **Bergen Place** i **Ballard**. Her erklærte bystyremedlemmer offisielt sommeren 2026 for «**Jimothy-sommeren**» til ære for Jimothy - en lokal vaskebjørn som hadde blitt en internetsensasjon for hans søt, rund kropp siden han har en unormalt kort ryggrad.

Ryan Henry Ward, en lokal kunstner fra Ballard og Seattle's mest kjente veggmalere, malte et bilde av Jimothy og solgte det på auksjon for 6 543,21 dollar; hele beløpet gikk uavkortet til **Ballard Food Bank**. Store lokale bedrifter ønsket å bidra og matchet beløpet, noe som førte til at de totale donasjonene nådde 271 000 dollar. Lokale næringsdrivende arrangerte «paint and sip» kvelder og salg av effekter for å holde bidragsstrømmen i gang. Store internasjonale merkevarer, byråer og kontoer i sosiale medier har også kastet seg på bølgen. Jimothy har blitt omtalt av blant annet **ABC News**, **The New York Times** og **The Washington Post**, og har oppnådd internasjonal berømmelse!

Hurrah for Jimothy !

On July 26, 2026, Seattle's Ballard neighborhood hosted a public celebration at Bergen Place Park where city council members officially proclaimed the summer of 2026 as "Jimothy Summer" to honor Jimothy, a viral local raccoon with short spine syndrome. Ballard resident and Seattle's most famous mural artist Ryan Henry Ward painted a picture of Jimothy and auctioned it off for \$6,543.21 giving all proceeds to the Ballard Food Bank. Major local corporations matched this and brought the donation up to \$271,000. Fantastisk! Jimothy has become world famous!
