NORWAY PARK NEWS

The Norway Park Board moved a few things closer to completion. The committee tasked with the research and decision on whether to repair our tractor and riding lawn mower decided that rather than repair them, it would be more practical in the long run to purchase new items. To repair the ones we have which are in the shop and non-working for the last several months would cost \$10,000 or more to rebuild. The Park would then have equipment that is 20 years old and should expect that something else would require repair in the next two years. The Board recommended putting down a \$500 refundable payment to make the order. Delivery would be late March. This is after the February Stockholders meeting where the issue can be decided by the Stockholders. If they decide against the proposal, the down payment is returnable.

Another committee has been working on categorizing the duties of the Caretaker and the various skills needed to do the job. Further a new employment agreement is being completed. The current Caretaker falls outside many of the skill sets and the committee decided it was best to relieve him of duty as of November 30, 2021 and begin a search for a new caretaker.

LEL COVID Policy


