He formed Hrafngardr Vikings and is part of the Northwest Viking Alliance with the intent to increase the understanding of Nordic life during the Viking Age rather than the Hollywood impressions that often emphasizes blood and gore. Seth is well versed in Viking everyday life but focuses on the life of a Viking warrior. Joining Seth will be Alan Andris (Alanus) and Pat Reed (Jorunn) who have also been involved in Viking Culture and have worked with Viking museums in the Nordic countries. Jorunn focuses on Viking cooking and nalbinding (a type of knitting style). Alanus's Viking role is as a merchant and an expert in Viking navigation. Alanus and Jorunn own Nordic Trader that makes many wonderful museum recreations of actual artifacts.
