

Jo Nesbø, a world famous Norwegian author, got his beginnings as a writer by reading Påske krim. As a child he was heavily influenced by this Norwegian tradition.

I personally learned to read Norwegian by reading Påske krim, and all the stories that come out every week in the local ukeblader. My grandmother would get Hjemmet, Ukeblad and Allers as well as the latest series of books by Scandinavian authors like Margit Sandemo. I am happy to say our bibliotek at the lodge has received many donations and we have a cart full of Norwegian mystery and romance novel paperbacks that you may check out! If you are learning Norwegian these are the perfect books for you! There is a lot of simple dialogue, and the intriguing plot keeps you turning the pages. 

In Memoriam

Margie Conover was our oldest member at the age of 108. She was born on February 25, 1915, and passed away on January 27, 2024. She was a proud lifelong member of the Ballard (Seattle) community. Margie was born in Seattle during WWI to Harold and Karen Nelson both immigrants from Norway. Margie grew up in the Ballard community, attending Crown Hill, Greenwood, and Ballard High School, graduating in 1933.
