IN MEMORIUM

Martin Lode passed away on April 13, 2023, at age 87, after a long fight with Parkinson's Disease. Martin joined the Lodge in 1971 and was a member for 50 years. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather and brother who will never be forgotten. He was born in Kleppe, Norway and came to work on his uncle's farm in Montana during the 1950's. He then joined the United States Marine Corp in 1956 and in 1964 he became a United States citizen. During that time he met Carol Mathisen, of Ballard, and they later married in 1963. Martin's entire life career was in construction which started when he went to work for The Cawdrey and Vemo Company in Ballard and ended when he retired as the owner/operator of The Lode Company. Martin is survived by his daughter Anita (Lode), two grandsons, Derrik and Dennis Olsen, two sisters, Ingeborg Gaard and Gunlaug Straume, and his brother Olav Lode. A memorial service was held on May 6th. The Memorial will go to the Leif Erikson Educational Foundation.

Linda Bjorndal passed away on May 4, 2023. She was married to Trygve Bjorndal for 52 years. She is survived by her husband Trygve and daughter Wendy. Trygve was a regular patron in Kaffestua and often played his accordion there for many years. Linda will be buried in Wisconsin. More details about Linda will be published at a later date. The memorial will go to the Leif Erikson Educational Foundation.


