NORWAY PARK NEWS



Hei allesammen! It's a farewell to summer's end, autumn is at our doorsteps with all its rustic wonders. Colder mornings with a warm and strong cup of coffee like a classic Norwegian, also time to start breaking out your favourite Norsk sweater.

To recap happenings at Norway Park, begins with the big Salmon Culvert state project under Highway 9, creating a big opening for the fish to travel from the upper part of the park to Lake Mc Murray. The project has been quite a massive project, even temporarily closing Highway 9, re-routing traffic, making those getting into the

park experiencing longer travel times. The culvert project currently is in the final stages of completion, and just like the early days of Norway Park, you can now clearly see the lake and lower park area.

The LERA board has decided to keep the classic gate at the entrance of the upper park, with new mechanical parts, replacing damaged mechanisms due to improperly forced entry with a vehicle this summer. The gate should be fully functioning before September's end, continuing with the key card entry system.

The Stockholder's meeting held on the 10th of September, had a vote on doing a study on the aging water system of Norway Park, the study would create a blueprint of updating the system throughout the park, which has been in place since 1963. As for the vote for this study, stockholder's overwhelming approved this measure which will be done by an engineering company who specializes in this field.

2023 will be the 60th Anniversary of Norway Park! Work has begun gearing up for this special year, looking for interesting photos of family and functions all the way back to the beginning of our park. An update for the Pavilion is underway for a new color scheme, drapes and lighting, this look is what will be known as "koselig" (cozy) - more fitting with a true Norwegian look and feel. SPORTS DIRECTOR NEWS



LEL COVID POLICY

Leif Erikson Lodge policy on addressing COVID concerns is as follows:

In accordance with King County the mask mandate ended on March 12, 2022 in public indoor spaces. Wearing masks is optional but if you feel more comfortable wearing a mask you are welcome to do so. Please do not attend lodge events if you are feeling ill. It doesn't mean the pandemic is over. There may be future surges or new variants that will lead us to reassess the need for additional masking recommendations and other measures to protect our community. Certain people may still want to wear masks. For this reason, the use of high-quality, well-fitting masks still makes sense for certain people, particularly in crowded indoor settings with poor ventilation. It is reasonable to continue to wear a mask in indoor public spaces if you are immunocompromised or at increased risk for severe disease, unvaccinated, or are in contact with someone at high risk. Some people may choose to wear a mask out of consideration for people who may be at high risk in public settings, or if they want to further reduce their own risk for any reason.
