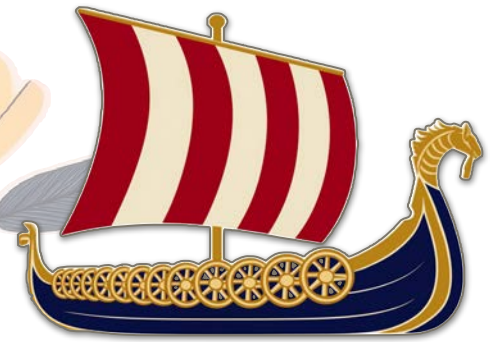

TUBFRIM

Thank you to all the lodges that collect stamps for Tubfrim, one of Norway's Special Projects that sells used postage stamps, with proceeds supporting financial aid to improve the quality of life for handicapped children and youth.

Clip the stamps off envelopes or packages received in the mail, leaving a ½-inch (1.50 cm) margin to protect the stamps. When you get a pound of stamps, write your name, address, phone number, lodge, and lodge number on a 3" by 5" card, then place the card with the stamps in a zip-lock bag. Or complete the Tubfrim form available in the office. Forever Stamps are acceptable. Please don't send stamps with damaged perforation, edges, etc. They will be thrown away. The cards are sent to the International Sons of Norway Office in Minneapolis and entered into a drawing.

The stamps will be delivered to Bothell Lodge to the Tubfrim coordinators for District 2, SON, who will arrange to have them shipped to Norway with no cost to the district except for boxing materials. This is a simple and easy way to contribute to one of the Sons of Norway's charitable projects.

For Leif Erikson Lodge members, deliver your stamps to the LEL office. Gail Engler is the point of contact and will deliver your stamps to the Bothell Lodge. Call ahead to make sure someone is at the LEL office to accept the stamps. 206-783-1274. Currently, the LEL office is open on Wednesdays and Fridays from 10:00-2:00. Tusen takk!

Påskekrim

There's only about 30 murders per year i Norge, and they are mostly solved. But if you read Norsk Noir, you'd think every sleepy village hides a gruesome scene!

Norge stands alone with its hunger for crime at Påske!

According to the **Norwegian Booksellers Association** the week before Påske up to 46 percent of adult books sold were crime novels!

In **Oslo** the annual **Krimfestivalen**, timed to Påske, is a free three-day book festival that celebrates local crime writers such as Jo Nesbø, Anne Holt, Thomas Enger, Jørn Lier Horst, Karin Fossum, Gunnar Staalesen and many more. Panels of famous authors are there to meet and greet, discuss writing "krim" and to sign books. This is also when **Rivertonprisen**, a prestigious crime writing award, is given. The award is named after the Norwegian journalist and author Sven Elvestad (1884-1934), who famously wrote detective stories under the pen name **Stein Riverton**. Last year the award went to Eva Fretheim (b. 1967) for "Fuglekongen" (The Bird King).

Visit the library at the lodge and check out our own little Påskekrim section. Many of our books are in English and we welcome book donations of Norwegian authors, so when you've finished your latest Norsk Påskekrim feel free to donate it to our library. **Tusen Takk og God Lesning!**

The library is open during Kaffestua and maybe you'll meet the librarians An-Magrith and Diana! Check the LEL calendar for updates.

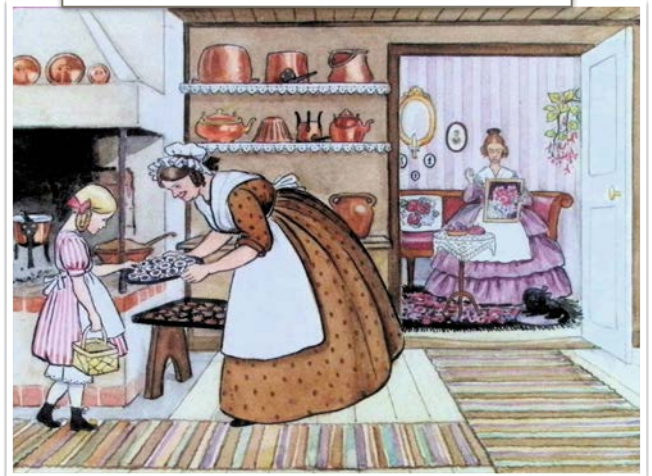
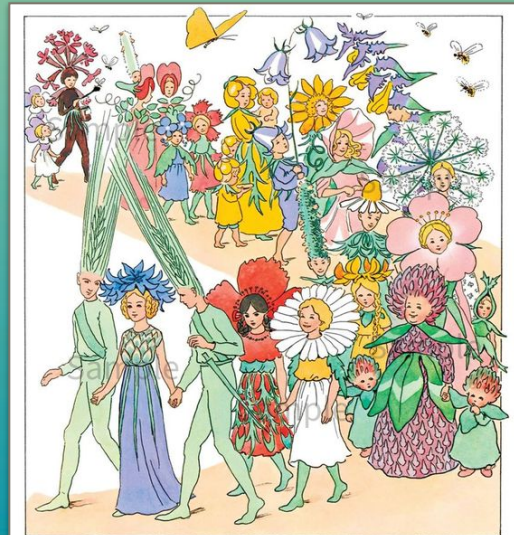

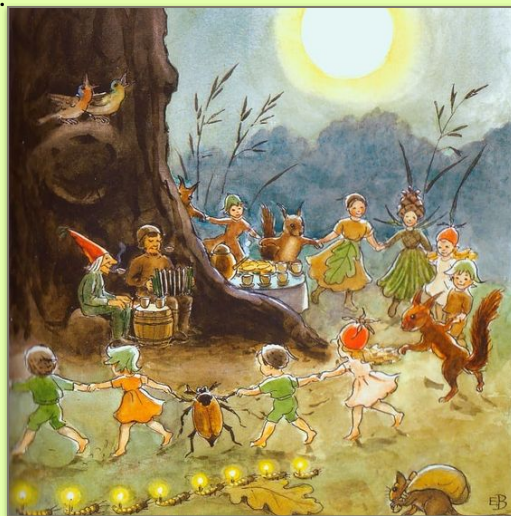
