WOOD CARVING CLASS



Wednesdays, January 10, 10:30 AM-1:30 PM

New beginner wood carving class for those of you who want to try it out for one day!

\$45 + \$25 for the material=\$70 total.

Wednesdays, January 17, 24, 31, 10:30 AM -1:30 PM

To continue in this class must attend the January 10 or December classes.

Woodcarving classes cover European-styled carving chisels and gouges, learn important carving techniques with wood and basic tool sharpening. The project design is a "Fleur-de-lis", a symbol used for centuries throughout Europe.

This style of carving is called "Dølaskurd" and typical for Gudbrandsdalen.

A basic set of tools is available to use in the class. The wood material is included in the class fee. Three class sessions, 3 hours per session / 9 hours total, 125.00 plus 25 material fee = 150 total.

About Mark: In 1984, after attending a series of crafts classes on

furniture restoration and ornamental woodcarving at Sätergläntan Hemslöjdens Gård in Insjön, Sweden, Mark spent the following 2 years training in ornamental woodcarving at Hjerleid Vidargaande Skole in Dovre, Norway (1985/86) and then under the guidance of master carvers Bengt Johansson and Jonas Carlsson in Tibro, Sweden (1986/87). Upon returning to the Seattle area, Mark worked with some local interior designers on custom projects such as the fire restoration at St. Mark's Cathedral on Capitol Hill. That led to the design and construction of mantels, doors and trim in the custom home market..
